Rifle Range Safety: We have had a number of incidents at the Rifle Pistol Range regarding the improper use of the warning light system for closing the Range to replace targets. The club policy is when the majority of shooters on the line have briefly stopped shooting you check down the line (with all shooters) and tell your fellow members you want to close the range. You turn the light on at your station. You then need to double check that all shooters have ceased firing and have unloaded their guns and placed them on the table. Do not proceed onto the field until all shooters have complied with this rule. After you have completed the target replacement ask the shooters on the line if everyone is ready to start shooting again. If so, turn the lights off and announce the "Range is Hot" which opens the field for shooting.
